

## CHS102 Ancient Chinese History (中国古代史概论)

### Synopsis:

CHS102 systematically expounds on the basic content and development of ancient Chinese history. Students will have a deeper understanding of ancient Chinese history, including the ancient Xia, Shang and Zhou, Qin and Han, Wei, Jin, Southern and Northern Dynasties, Sui, Tang and Five Dynasties, Song, Liao, Xia, Jin, Yuan, Ming and Qing Dynasties. The content will involve politics, economy, military, education, culture, literature, art, etc. in various historical periods of China, focusing on the developmental context and basic characteristics of each historical period.

### Topics:

- Ancient Xia, Shang and Zhou dynasties 上古夏商周
- The Spring and Autumn Period and the Warring States Period 春秋战国
- Qin and Western Han Dynasty 秦、西汉
- Eastern Han Dynasty and the Three Kingdoms 东汉三国
- Jin Dynasty and Sixteen Kingdoms 两晋十六国
- Northern and Southern Dynasties 南北朝
- Early Sui and Tang Dynasties 隋唐前期
- Late Tang Dynasty and the Five Dynasties and Ten Kingdoms 唐后期五代十国
- Song and Liao 宋辽
- Xia, Jin and Yuan 夏金元
- Ming Dynasty 明
- Qing Dynasty 清
