## Synopsis:

Configure and implement the SAP business processes (such as payment, dunning and individual closing). Make effective use of overhead cost orders with SAP R/3 to plan, clear and analyze overhead costs in Controlling and use the Schedule Manager for periodic closing. Use Profit Center Accounting for profit reports and analyze data structures using the report painter. This course does not carry a Grade Point Value (GPV), but it will count towards fulfilling the credit requirements of the degree.
