

1. As part of the graduation requirement, students must complete at least 10 cu of level 3 courses & above in the minor.
2. The minor is recommended for BSc Biomedical Engineering students.
3. For students from other programmes, it is recommended to complete BME107 Anatomy and Physiology and BME108 Physiology and Infectious Diseases before taking the minor.
4. Students must take either PAR307 Leadership in Paramedicine or PAR309 Operational Leadership in Paramedicine.
5. For PAR307, students are to attend one week of face-to-face sessions at JIBC, Canada.
6. For PAR309, students are to attend six weeks of face-to-face sessions at JIBC, Canada. PAR309 is compulsory for SAF/SCDF-sponsored students
7. The minor is only applicable to students enrolled in 2023/01 and before.
