

1. Students need to complete at least 10 cu of level 3 and above courses in the minor.
2. 10 cu free electives are applicable to students enrolled before the July 2023 semester only.
3. Students need to complete 15 cu of courses in the Thematic stage, including:
 - a) OGP103 Introduction to ASEAN
 - b) Any 2 courses from the Minor Elective (Thematic) category.
4. Students need to complete 15 cu of courses in the Immersive stage, by undertaking of these options:
 - a) Option A: 24-week overseas work attachment (15 cu)
 - b) Option B: 16-week overseas work attachment (10 cu) and any 1 of the following: courses in the Minor Elective (Immersive) category or an overseas Industry-based Study Programme (IBSP).
 - c) Option C: 8-week overseas work attachment (5 cu) and any 2 of the following: courses in the Minor Elective (Immersive) category or an overseas IBSP.
5. To be admitted into the minor, interested students need to arrange and confirm the overseas work attachment with the Career Development Office (CDO). For more details, please contact your career mentor or careerdev@suss.edu.sg.
